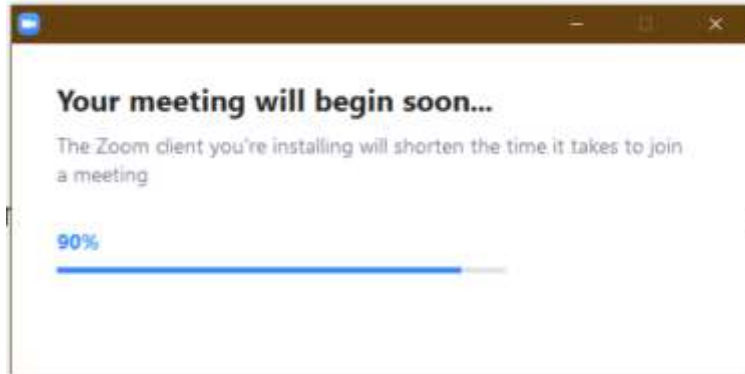
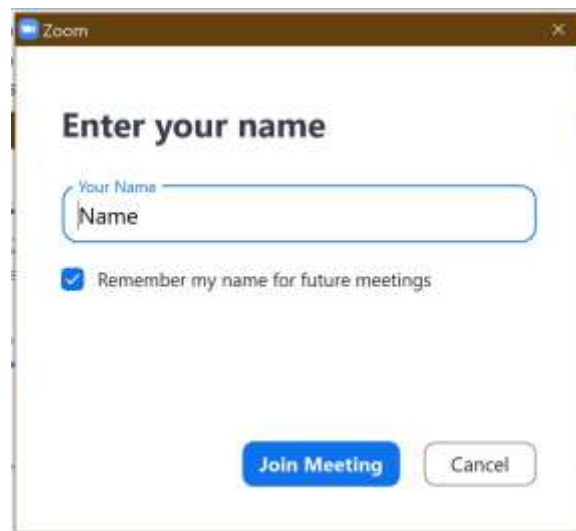


1. Click on the Zoom conference link (see <https://www.fupc-cambridge.org/covid> for the link). A download should start automatically.
2. Click on the downloaded file. The Zoom application will begin to install, and you will see the following status prompt:



If the installation pauses at this step in the process, there may be a separate window prompting for your authorization to complete the installation.

3. You will be prompted to enter your name. Then click "Join Meeting"



- A picture of yourself will appear, with the prompt below. Click “Join with Video” or “Join without Video” depending on whether or not you would like to share video of yourself with the other callers.

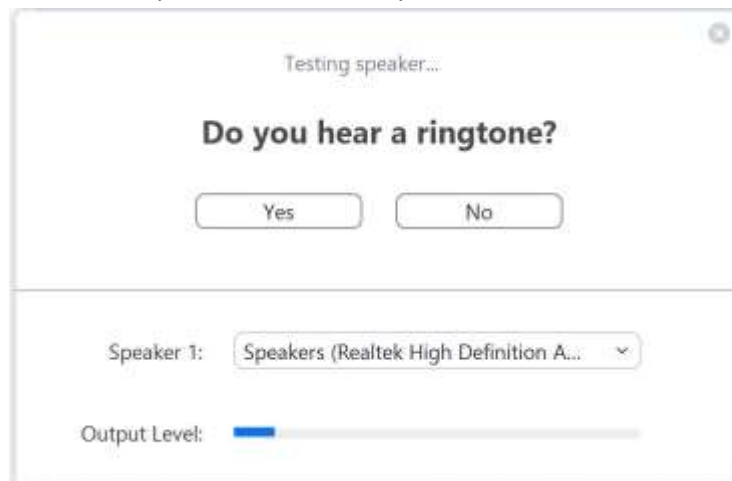
Always show video preview dialog when joining a video meeting



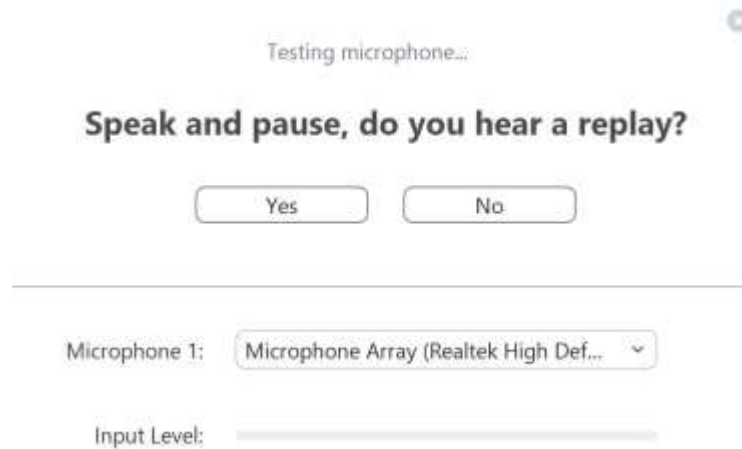
- Next the following prompt will appear. Click “Test Speaker and Microphone” to confirm that these are working properly.



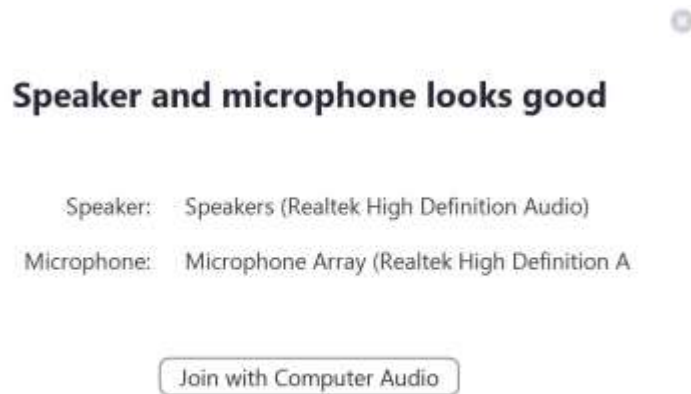
- The following prompt will appear. Click “Yes” if you hear a ringtone. If you do not hear a ringtone, select an alternate speaker from the drop-down menu.



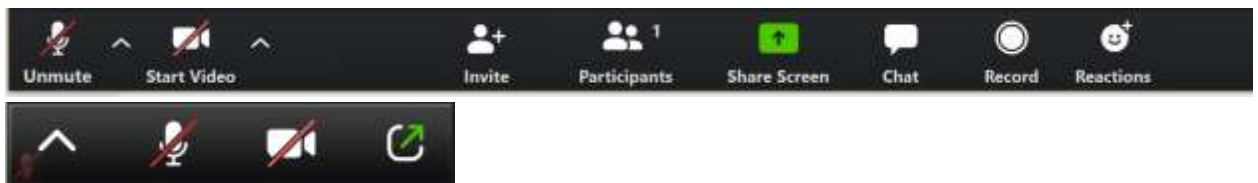
- Next the microphone test will appear. Speak briefly, and you should hear your voice echoed. If you do not hear anything, select an alternate microphone from the drop-down menu and try again.



- You should see the following prompt, confirming that your audio equipment is working. Click "Join with Computer Audio"



- The prompt from step #5 will appear again. Click "Join with Computer Audio". The ZOOM application will appear with one of the following sets of controls.



10. Your installation is complete! To join the service on Sunday, simply click on the ZOOM link on the Cambridge Presbyterian webpage <https://www.fupc-cambridge.org/covid>. You will see something like the following prompt. Click “Open Zoom” and the ZOOM application will open the video call.
